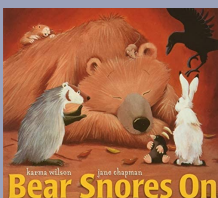

Take a walk around the library and read the winter story: **Bear Snores On** by Karma Wilson and Jane Chapman. There will be hibernation crafts and activities in the library.



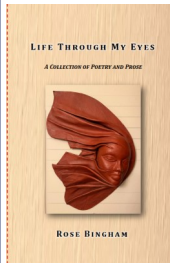
Annual Library Open House: Discover the Magic at your Library Special Performance by Comedian & Magician Jeff McMullen -10 am

The January book selection is *Elizabeth is Missing* by Emma Healey. This darkly riveting debut novel is a sophisticated psychological mystery that is heartbreakingly honest about memory, identity, and aging. An elderly woman descending into dementia embarks on a desperate quest to find the best friend she believes has disappeared, and her search for the truth will go back decades and have shattering consequences. We will be discussing this book twice in the month of January: **Wednesday, January 25 at 1:30 pm & Monday, January 30 at 5:30 pm.** Copies of the book are available at the library, on the bookmobile and on Hoopla.
