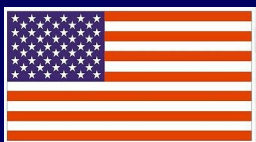

## Summer Programs for All Ages

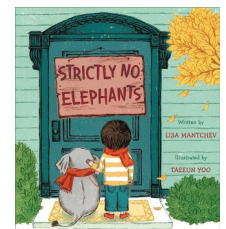
